## Notice

1. All students are required to know that the college is conducting online examination of LLB and BALLB 1<sup>st</sup> year (2017 pattern) from 26<sup>th</sup> December to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 as per timetable.
2. The college has decided to conduct the examination online considering the COVID pandemic. The students will receive link for login (username and password) on their registered mobile phone through SMS and email.(<https://admin.liveexam.co.in/> )
3. The student can use either laptop or mobile for the said examination.
4. The notification should be blocked first and popup should be allowed.
5. Student should use latest browser. (Google chrome/Mozilla Firefox/ Internet explorer).
6. The students should make sure that the Internet speed should be good.
7. The concerned examination is **proctored**; hence any use of websites or copying will be noted and intimated through warnings. Any further attempt will result in the debarment from the concerned examination. It shall result in taking disciplinary action against the concerned student.
8. The student will initially get the link for mock test, which they have to complete any time within two days 22<sup>st</sup> and 23<sup>nd</sup> December, 2020.
9. In case students face any problem regarding login or any other related to mock test, they should immediately contact the college on 020-24221002.
10. When students will receive their username and default password, they have to change the password initially. Later they can use the same username and password for all papers.
11. The students appearing for the examination will be given 60 questions. Only fifty correct answers will be considered for final result, they will be given 60 minutes to complete the individual paper.
12. The time counting will begin, when the student logs in for the paper. The students are expected to submit the paper or it will end after time limit of 60 minutes is over.
