### **Instructions:**

1. The examination will be conducted online. All relevant communication related to examination will be done through the email on registered email address and sms on registered mobile number. It is suggested not to change email address and mobile number till completion of examination Oct/Nov 2020.
2. Students need to check the papers in the portal by login.
3. For physically challenged students for the online examination, time will automatically get set to 80 minutes. The physically challenged students can take help of assistant during the online examination.
4. Candidate shall appear for the online examination from the place of their convenience.
5. Candidate can log in using their mobile, laptop, PC or I-Pad. Please take care that batteries of these units are properly charged prior to examination and also connected through internet facility.
6. In case of any technical difficulty during the examination, software support is provided by the college. On-line examination will get resumed for the remaining duration in case of technical interruptions during the examinations. Answers of the questions attempted by the student before occurrence of the interruption will get saved automatically on service provider's server. A mock test will be provided to all students. The dates of the mock-test will get communicated to students through college website.
7. All questions are Multiple Choice Questions having single correct option.
8. Each question carry 1 mark.
9. Test duration – 60 mins. Specially Abled Students are allowed 20 mins more for examination. The students will be given 60 questions in each paper. However only any 50 correct answers will be considered for the result of that paper.
10. The marks for the respective examinations will be converted as per the Savitribai Phule Pune University approved scheme in this regard .The marks obtained by the student out of 50 in this examination will be converted into the marks obtained out of 80 marks.
11. Please make sure you make the final submission only after completing the examination. You will be asked to confirm in case you accidentally try submitting the examination before the completion of the duration. Please note that once you make the final submission, you will not be able to take up the examination again.
12. It is going to be a proctored exam. If students are found doing malpractice, the paper gets submitted automatically after a 10 warnings.
13. Students should not resort to use of unfair means during examination, otherwise action will be initiated as per the SPPU rules and regulations.
